
International DN Ice Yacht Racing Association



Minutes of the meeting of national secretaries, 10th-11th of May'86, Salzburg, Austria.

1. Present were:

Herbert Hörmann, Austria; Endel Voorema, SU; Peter Schellhorn, BRD; Motek Duchowski, Poland; Wim van Acker, Holland. Sweden, Finland and Italy had sent their opinions and votes by letter.

2. First races were in Finland in October '35. Next races in Rechensee, Italy during Christmas, with smooth ice and a lot of wind. The EC and WC which had been planned in Austra, had to be cancelled due to bad iceconditions.

We would like to express here our heartfelt thanks to all the Austrians for their efforts to organize races in Austria and for their willingness to cooperate with the iceboaters from Northern Germany to hold the races in Schlei, BRD.

In spite of the promising prospects, racing was impossible after a few days. In accordance to the rules, no further change of place was allowed, so this meant the end of the EC & WC.

Then the only alternative left, was organizing an international race. Such has been tried in Viborg, Danmark, but also in vain, as depressions dominated the weather in the whole area.

In the rest of the season, races have been held in several countries, and after all the season has been satisfactory.

- 3. The financial situation has been controlled and aproved and is satisfactory.
- 4. Wim van Acker has been re-elected as European Commodore.
- 5. The ET & EC will be held in Germany, 14th 21th of Februar '87, alternative country Sweden. If not possible, second date: 14th -21th of March, Poland.
- 6. SU is willing to organize the ET, EC & WC 87/88. In this connection, the following questions rose:
- a. Are competitors allowed to travel the shortest way from Brest to Tallinn and Leningrad to minimize travelcosts?
- b. Is it possible to limit the hotelexpenses to 80 DM max./day? Because of its stable exchange rate, preferred currency is DM.
- c. No visa limitations for IDNIYRA members.
- d. Is it possible to arrange satisfactory telephone communication to/from the SU to where the gasts are boused avoid situations undesirable where for days communication with family abroad was impossible?
