

**World & European championship 2014 DN Junior and Ice-Optimist  
European Cup 2014  
17th – 22nd February, 2014 Riga, Latvia  
Notice of race**

**1. Organising authority and venue**

The organizing authority of Regatta is Latvian DN Ice sailing association in cooperation with JK "AUDA" and IDNIYRA Europe Society e.V. represented by Junior Program Manager.

Partners: Council of Riga

The primary site is Lake Kisezers, Riga, Latvia. Various other sailing areas in Latvia, Estonia, Lithuania and Poland can be used to provide this regatta.

The championship regatta will be sailed under jurisdiction of International DN Ice Yacht Racing Association (IDNIYRA).

**2. Eligibility**

All competitors shall be members of their National DN Fleets. All DN and Ice-Optimist ice-yachts shall meet the requirements of Official Class Specifications.

**3. Age limits**

Ice Optimist – birth year 1998 and younger

DN Junior - birth year 1993 and younger

**4. Entry and registration.**

Link to online registration on official IDNIYRA Europe website (Junior section) will be available from 2nd January, 2014 and must be completed latest 2nd February, 2014. All entries received later than 2nd February, 2014 will be considered as late and double entry fee will be stated. Entries at check-in are only accepted with a proof of valid insurance, which has to be presented on check-in.

**Entry fee:**

DN Junior – 30,- EUR; Ice Optimist – 30,- EUR

**Late entry fee:**

DN Junior – 60,- EUR; Ice Optimist – 60,- EUR

**5. Schedule of event**

Final racing site selection will be made not later than 16th February 2014, 12.00 and announced on IDNIYRA-Europe website <http://idniyra.eu>

**Monday, 17th February**

Practice races 12.00 – 16.00

**Tuesday, 18th February**

Practice races, voluntary measurement in harbour 12.00 – 15.00

Regatta check-in 16.00 – 20.00

**Wednesday, 19th February**

Opening ceremony on the ice 10.00  
First start 11.00

**Thursday, 20th February**

First start of the day 11.00

**Friday, 21st February**

First start of the day 11.00

**Saturday, 22nd February**

WC/EC if less than 3 races are completed in each class, first start of the day 10.00

European Cup 2014 will start on Saturday 22nd February if 3 or more races are finished on WC/EC by the end of Friday 21st of February evening or the next day after WC/EC is completed in full.

Seven (7) races in each class are scheduled for WC/EC. Minimum of three (3) races in each class have to be sailed for a valid regatta. Five (5) races in each class are scheduled for European cup 2014. Minimum of three (3) races in each class have to be sailed for a valid regatta.

**6. Sailing instructions**

Sailing instructions will be supplied by organizer and available to all participants at check in.

**7. Races, scoring, advertising**

Races and scoring will be managed according to IDNIYRA By-Laws, NIA Sailing Rules and the Sailing Instructions. IDNIYRA By-Law B.12 will apply with the amendment that each participant may be obligated to attach advertisement or other information from organizers to the hull.

**8. Liability and insurance**

The Organizing Authority of the Event and all parties involved in Organizing it do not accept any liability for loss of life and property, personal injury or damage of property. Every competitor is responsible in every respect for the way he or she sails. Each competitor shall produce evidence of valid third party liability insurance of a minimum of 500.000,- EUR coverage. It will be possible to buy single event insurance for sailors without valid insurance documents at check in.

**9. Measurement**

Each boat shall be available for the measurement inspection from the first race until the end of regatta. Measurement and rules compliance inspections may be carried out throughout the regatta before or after each race.

**10. Prizes**

Ten first sailors and top three girls from each group will be awarded. Organizers and sponsors can award with other and special prizes.

**11. Anti-Doping policy**

IDNIYRA-Europe has implemented the Anti-Doping Program of The World Anti-Doping Agency. Thus during training and the regatta the misuses of alcohol or drugs will not be tolerated.

**12. Further Information**

The organizers shall be contacted for the accommodation possibilities.  
The organizers will help to get a visa, if needed, not later than 6 weeks before the event takes place.
