DN Junior and Ice-Optimist World Championship 2015 February 17 – 20, 2015 in Sweden. Training day February 16, 2015

Dear Friends,

On behalf of the IDNIYRA Europe and the Swedish Ice Sailing Federation we invite all young Ice sailors to Sweden for the DN Junior and Ice-Optimist World Championship 2015. The motto for the event is "Safety and Sportsmanship".

1. Organising authority and venue.

The World Championship 2015 for DN Junior and Ice-Optimist will be organised by the Swedish Ice Sailing Federation and the Swedish Ice-Optimist Class under authority of IDNIYRA-Europe represented by the Junior Programme Manager. The championship regatta will be sailed under jurisdiction of International DN Ice Yacht Racing Association (IDNIYRA), NIA Racing Rules and JWC 2015 Sailing Instructions provided at check in.

The primary sailing site is Vasteras but other sailing areas in Sweden can be used if necessary to finish the Regatta.

2. Eligibility.

All competitors shall be members of their National DN or Ice-Optimist fleets. All DN and Ice-Optimist ice yachts shall meet the requirements of Official Class Specifications. Ice-Optimists must have disc and Optimist logo in sail.

3. Age limits

DN Junior – birth year 1993 and younger Ice-Optimist – birth year 1999 and younger

4. Entry and registration.

Online registration on official IDNIYRA Europe website http://idniyra.eu will be available from December 10, 2014 All entries received later than 9th February, 2015 will be considered as late and double entry fee will be charged. Entries are only accepted with a proof of insurance, which has to be presented at check-in.

Seven (7) races in each class are scheduled for JWC 2015. Minimum three (3) races in one class (DN Junior or Ice-Optimist) have to be sailed for a valid regatta.

A European Cup 2015 will be sailed only if JWC is completed (7 races in each class) before end of Thursday Feb 19th. Five (5) races in each class are scheduled for European cup 2015. Minimum of three (3) races in one class have to be sailed for a valid regatta.

8. Races, scoring, advertising.

The championships will be sailed and scored in compliance with NIA Sailing Rules, IDNIYRA By-Laws, Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may be modified at the Skippers Meeting.

9. Race course and finish

For safety reasons 2 dolly marks at both windward and leeward marks will be used. Scorers, spectators and sailors not racing must stand behind starting line during race. See enclosed drawings

10 Liability and insurance.

The Organising Authority of the Event and all parties involved in organising it do not accept any liability for loss of life and property nor personal injury or damage of property. Every competitor is responsible in every respect for the way he or she sails.

Entries are only accepted with a proof of valid third party liability insurance that must be presented at check-in. Minimum insurance amount 500 000€. Single event insurance policy can be bought at check in. Cost 30 EUR per sailor.

11. Measurement

Each boat shall be available for measurement inspection from the first race until the end of regatta. Measurement and rules compliance inspections may be carried out throughout the regatta before or after each race.

12. Prizes

Ten first sailors and top three girls from each group will be awarded. Organizers and sponsors can award with other and special prizes.

13. Anti-Doping policy.

IDNIYRA -Europe has implemented the Anti-Doping Programme of the World Anti-doping Agency.

14. Accommodation

Information about accommodation will be posted on the regatta website


